- 62 people contacted PBL for literacy assistance

Last year, we saw a growing need for older adults seeking help with technology, which led to a new partnership with Senior Planet, a division of AARP (www.seniorplanet.org). We've just completed our first course, Computer Essentials, and are excited to offer even more courses in 2025! This fall, we've also seen a surge in new students eager to learn English, prompting us to bring back our English classes. Additionally, our tutoring services are busier than ever, with many students focused on English language skills and HiSET/GED preparation. By keeping our program small and personalized, we're able to quickly adapt to the evolving needs of our community. We are incredibly grateful for our supportive board and a community that continues to champion our mission!

New ESL Class!

When we learned about a group of seven locals in need of basic English skills, we immediately sprang into action. We quickly secured a teacher and initial funding to get a class started for them. We were fortunate to find Heather Vernon, a former volunteer who transitioned to staff, to lead the class. Heather holds a Master's degree in Teaching English for Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) with 12+ years experience in the field. We are thrilled to have her on board. Since this group shares a common work schedule, we've arranged for their classes to take place at times that don't conflict with work. They meet twice a week and enjoy learning together. We're excited to watch their progress in the months ahead.
